A pin, VW tool no. 2064, is used to fix the pump position while the timing belt is removed. The camshaft and pump work against spring pressure and will move out of position when the timing belt is removed.

Tighten the nut to 20-23Nm. Rotate the crankshaft for two rounds to the TDC, last 45° smoothly without stopping. Ensure that the timing marks are aligned. VW Diesels are "interference" engines which means the valves and the pistons occupy the same space at different times. The Volkswagen timing belt keeps them in time. Don't bet your engine on a cheap timing belt, especially if it is a diesel. Make sure you only use high quality Continental timing belts. VW recommended changing interval is 30K miles.
